

Ships and Shipyards.

The POC Instructions - Rev 1a included the following addition:

Shipyards sites are to be used only by people who actually worked at the shipyard or on ships while they were being constructed or overhauled at the shipyard. People who only worked aboard a ship after it was constructed may not use the shipyard where it was constructed as their exposure site. They must list the name of the ship on which they served as their site. Any additional information and evidence which may be helpful in establishing exposure to Thurston Asbestos should also be included – such as the ship designator indicating the class and hull number and the location and year(s) of construction or overhaul.
