The NARCO Trust wants to remind you of the upcoming deadline pertaining to submission of form affidavits. The Directives regarding "Form" Affidavits and Conditional Language can be downloaded here:

It is important that you read this policy and understand what it means for claimants you represent. "Form" affidavits submitted on or after October 1, 2017, will not be considered by the claims processor absent exceptional circumstances.

A "form" affidavit is an affidavit that contains exposure allegations that use identical descriptive language as the language contained in other exposure affidavits submitted to the Trust.

Ultimately, it is the Trustees' decision in an exercise of their discretion whether an affidavit is a "form" affidavit that lacks sufficient indicia of reliability to be considered by the claims processor.

Further, if a claim is withdrawn or deemed withdrawn and subsequently re-filed, the affidavit shall be deemed submitted as of the date on which the affidavit is submitted with the refiled claim.
