Manville Trust Standards for Pathological Evidence of Asbestosis

- Ferruginous bodies identified as asbestos bodies.
- <u>Histopathological Findings</u>: Acceptable if related to asbestos exposure:
- ◆ A pattern of peribronchiolar fibrosis
- Increased evidence of collagen in the walls of the respiratory bronchioles
- Fibrosis in the walls of the terminal bronchioles or alveolar ducts
- Fibrosis of the alveolar septa
- Sub-pleural fibrosis in the alveoli closest to the bronchioles
- ♦ Honeycomb changes in the lower lobes
- Interstitial fibrosis is not found only around the tumor site.
