Temporary Policy Changes – COVID 2019

The Trustee of the MLC Trust recognizes these difficult and unusual times. Some filers may be unable to meet the traditional requirements for authentication of documents. Until a subsequent notice is sent, the following temporary policy will be in place:

- A release document or other affidavit that currently requires notarization or two unrelated witnesses may be signed by the Injured Party or Personal Representative (when the injured party is deceased) and one witness who *may be* related by blood or marriage.

The Trust also makes the following permanent policy change: The Trust will accept any document requiring a signature that has been signed utilizing DocuSign or other approved electronic signature software. The Trust may require submission of a DocuSign certification, history, or similar documentation related to the use of electronic signatures.
