

STATEMENT REGARDING STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS CHANGES-
Updated November 7, 2013

This statement is being provided to give notice that the deadline for changes to the Statute of Limitations (“SOL”) has been extended to **November 30, 2013**. As previously communicated, the C.E. Thurston & Sons Asbestos Trust (“Trust”) has directed CRMC to make changes to the SOL calculation. These changes to the SOL calculation are as follows. Electronic filers must submit adequate information within the Proof of Claim and run the Categorization Decision Tree (CDT) to elevate their filing to the proper status to toll the statute of limitations. Hybrid filers must submit adequate information within the Proof of Claim Form and the requisite supporting documents for the claimed disease to elevate their filing to the proper status to toll the statute of limitations. For hybrid filer types the date the documents are uploaded to CRMC must be prior to the deadline date noted above. All statuses prior to this point will be considered drafts and do not constitute "claims" for the purposes of the Trust Distribution Procedures. As such, these drafts will not toll the statute of limitations.

Filers associated with drafts that were created prior to this updated notice will have until November 30, 2013 to convert those drafts to claims and submit them to the Trust. Any such draft filed and converted to a claim on or before November 30, 2013 will be deemed to have tolled the statute of limitations as of the create date of the draft. Any drafts that are not converted by November 30, 2013 and any future filings with the Trust will use the date a draft is converted to a claim to toll the statute as specified above by filer type.
